

## THE PASTORS CORNER

At the time of my writing for this month's newsletter, we are in the midst of our most sustained heat this summer of 2023. Several days will be pushing triple digits without any humidity or heat index added to the forecast. Therefore, if you are looking for an excuse to stay in the A/C or place yourself in front of your favorite fan, then I'd encourage you to get a copy of the book I read this summer, and one that has helped me through our summer sermon series "Journeying Through Genesis".

The Flawed Family of God: Stories about the Imperfect Families in Genesis by Rev. Dr. Carolyn Helsel and Dr. Suzie Park has been a great book for me, and I believe that it can be a thought provoking book for you as well. Both the authors of this book are professors at Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Austin, TX. They each bring a wealth of knowledge to this book, both from a technical perspective in regards to the theology and the ancient Hebrew language/cultural norms of the age, as well as, from relating the material to our modern context of the 2020s. It is a very accessible book for all to read, and includes questions at the end of each chapter to reflect upon, if you'd like to use this book for your own book study around the foundational family of our faith.

The book focuses on the first three generations of the patriarchs from whom we attribute our religion and faith coming out of their agreements with God. The Flawed Family of God analyzes each character within these stories, and the roles that they play. Some characters are acknowledged as furthering ancient stereotypes and others are shown in a new light that I had never thought about. This book does a great job at taking stories that are rarely talked about in-depth, and doing a deep dive into who these people are and how we relate to them. It highlights the humans who are placed above others due to their faith or their actions in our biblical text, while also showing us that they are still imperfect beings. As always with books that bring about new perspectives, and to some may be asking uncomfortable questions, I have my issues with some of the ways they relate stories to modern times, or some of their choices in writing this book, but that is something I enjoy in a book like this. The more questions, the more I can advance my thoughts and my faith as use this as another resource to study and learn. If you have a chance, I encourage you to read this, less than 150 page book, about the family who forms the covenant with God, and the reality that they are more like us than we may have thought before.

### Treasurer's report:

Mitchells Presbyterian Church Family:

The budget approved by Session for 2023 was \$143,990.62. This represents the anticipated expenditures for the year and hopefully the collections in the form of tithes and offerings.

I want to update you as to our status through the second quarter (January through June).

Based on the budget we would hope to have collected \$71,995.71 and to have expended that amount (1/2 of \$143,990.62). As of June 30, 2023:

Collections of tithes and offerings and various other revenue (poll rent, investment revenue, miscellaneous collections)-\$71,785.96 - which is \$209.35 less than the anticipated.

Operating expenditures - \$65,233.15 - which is \$6,762.16 less than the anticipated.

Therefore, we are looking at a net overage of \$6,552.81 (\$6,762.16- \$209.35) as far as meeting the budget/anticipated expenditures for operations.

I would like to express my sincere thanks to each and every one of you for your continued support.



#### as established by 2022 MPC Sessio

- Roles to be filled on committees:
  Chair of Committee
  - Vice Chair of Committee
  - Member of Session to serve as liaison
    - Pastor serves as Ex Officio on all church committees as able

\*Note: Committee Members can hold multiple roles at once, and committees are tasked to fill membership roles and positions on their own.

- There must be a minimum of three members on each committee, and committees must have 50% of membership at their meeting to conduct business.
- All committees are to keep records of meetings of what occurred/actions taken.
  - Should provide small reports to be published after meetings to inform the church of committee actions/plans.
  - Liaisons are responsible for providing reports to session following each meeting.

#### Overall Tasks and Structures for All Committees, cont. (as established by 2022 MPC Session)

- The session should publish and/or provide an explanation of when/how to be a member of a committee if desired.
- Committees are tasked with actively seeking out new full voice members to serve, as well as, seek members to be in participation with the tasks of said committee.

#### Mission Statement Created at 2022 Session Retreat:

"We, the session of Mitchells Presbyterian Church, believe in peace, love and service based in the light of Jesus Christ. In order to grow and serve through adaptive ministry, we seek to expand our outreach and grow our family of faith. By providing for the community with our resources, our energy and our hearts, we work to show and teach the love of Jesus Christ through our actions".

#### PC(USA) Constitutional Questions for Ruling Elders

a. Do you trust in Jesus Christ your Savior, acknowledge him Lord of all and Head of the Church, and through him believe in one God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?

b. Do you accept the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments to be, by the Holy Spirit, the unique and authoritative witness to Jesus Christ in the Church universal, and God's Word to you?

c. Do you sincerely receive and adopt the essential tenets of the Reformed faith as expressed in the confessions of our church as authentic and reliable expositions of what Scripture leads us to believe and do, and will you be instructed and led by those confessions as you lead the people of God?

d. Will you fulfill your ministry in obedience to Jesus Christ, under the authority of Scripture, and be continually guided by our confessions?

e. Will you be governed by our church's polity, and will you abide by its discipline? Will you be a friend among your colleagues in ministry, working with them, subject to the ordering of God's Word and Spirit?

f. Will you in your own life seek to follow the Lord Jesus Christ, love your neighbors, and work for the reconciliation of the world?

g. Do you promise to further the peace, unity, and purity of the church?

h. Will you pray for and seek to serve the people with energy, intelligence, imagination, and love?

i. (1) (For ruling elder) Will you be a faithful ruling elder, watching over the people, providing for their worship, nurture, and service? Will you share in government and discipline, serving in councils of the church, and in your ministry will you try to show the love and justice of Jesus Christ?
