Prayer Shawl Ministry, Dorcas' Daughters

Greetings from Dorcas' Daughters.

Our group is named after Dorcas, an early disciple of Jesus mentioned in Acts of the Apostles (Acts 9:36-43). She lived in the port city of Joppa, today absorbed by Tel Aviv. Acts describes her as being known for her "good works and acts of mercy," sewing clothes for the poor. When she died, the widows of her community mourned her and sent urgently for Peter. As evidence of her charity, they showed him some of the clothes she had sewn. According to the biblical account, he raised her from the dead. We chose to name our group after her because we make our shawls, lap robes, baby blankets and quilts out of love and care for those who are ill, having surgery, celebrating the arrival of a new baby, etc.

We recently held our first "evening" meeting at the church. It was great fun with lots of stitching, conversation and laughter. We invite anyone who would like to join us to attend our next meeting at Mitchells on Monday, June 29, at 5:30 pm. If you don't knit or crochet but would like to learn, we would be happy to teach you.

We want to send a reminder that there are shawls, baby blankets and quilts available to be blessed if you know of someone who would like to receive one. There are items available in various sizes, lap blankets, and baby blankets. Members are always working on new projects. This ministry is an opportunity to share in the community and help others during times of need or celebration in their lives. Contact one of our members if you have any questions.
